# **Faculty Leadership Council**

This body, consisting of the Leadership of the Academic Senate, Department Chairs Council, and the All Faculty Association met at the AFA House on Monday, Feb. 5, 3:00-4:15. We discussed the issue of next steps with the Guided Pathways Grant program, specially, purviews and processes regarding the management of the grant money and selection of faculty: what will be the process for deciding which faculty members are selected for a Guided Pathways work group/task force; what processes will be developed for deciding to whom, and how much reassigned time is allocated, etc. We agreed that we need such processes to make it fair and transparent.
