

SRJC Placement Rules for Math

High School Data	Placement Rule
Passed Precalculus with C or better	<p>May take Math 1A or Math 4</p> <p><i>Possible recommendation: If a student has GPA < 3.2 and is not currently enrolled in calculus, it is recommended that the student take Math 27 (or Math 25 and Math 58) before taking Math 1A or Math 4.</i></p>
Passed Algebra II or Integrated Math 3 with C or better	<p>May take Math 9, 10, 15, 16, 25, 27, 58 or any pre-transfer level mathematics</p> <p><i>Possible recommendation: If a student has GPA < 2.6 and is not currently enrolled in precalculus, it is recommended that the student takes Math 154 or Math 156 before enrolling in Math 9, 16, 25, 27, or 58.</i></p>
Did not pass Algebra II or Integrated Math 3 with C or better and $GPA \geq 2.9$	<p>May take Math 15 or Math 10 or any pre-transfer level mathematics.</p> <p>Math 154 or Math 156 is required before taking any of the BSTEM transfer level courses: 9, 16, 25, 27, 58.</p> <p><i>Possible recommendation: If taking Math 15, concurrent enrollment in support class Math 215 is recommended.</i></p>
Did not pass Algebra II or Integrated Math 3 with C or better and $GPA < 2.9$	<p>May take Math 15 if enrolled concurrently in support class Math 215 or any pre-transfer level mathematics.</p> <p>Math 154 or Math 156 is required before taking any of the BSTEM transfer level courses: 9, 16, 25, 27, 58.</p>
