Guided Pathways

The Guided Pathways Workgroup will be bringing us an update on March 6th. They are even now preparing documents for distribution to the senate and we are aiming for those documents to be sent to you a week before the meeting. I think good things are going on within that group. I have also asked the group to bring to this body in a separate presentation an account of the money. The Academic Senate has the oversight of the whole process, and it is time for us to look at how the money is being spent, ask questions and give feedback.

A new development has changed the Guided Pathways process, however. This will not affect the immediately ensuing senate discussions, but we have to figure out how to respond to this. The whole memo is posted. I will read a portion . . .

So, there will be no sign on for year two. Apparently, the chancellor is now accounting our signing on to year one to be good for the whole five years. There are still conditions under newly announced guidelines. April 30 for “Scale of Adoption Self-Assessment” and September 30 for certifying a final version.
