#### **ACTION:**

1. Constitution/Bylaws, Exec Eligibility – Constitution/Bylaws Subcommittee (10 + 1) 30 m The Senate shall decide how to structure an election of the whole electorate regarding constitutional changes to Article IV; options on the table are a) allow any member of the electorate, including adjunct faculty, to run for president; and b) require that the president and vice president must be tenured, but create a new designated adjunct seat on the executive committee. The Senate has voted no to send options a and b separately, sequentially (6-19) and voted no (12-13) to send a ballot immediately with three options (a, b, and c=status quo). The Senate must still decide how to present the options to the electorate.
