

Proposed SRJC Six-School Academic Affairs Reorganization, Draft 2 (9-10-26)

Conceptual rationale: organize the schools primarily around what faculty teach and the academic affinity among disciplines, while keeping collegewide instructional infrastructure centralized.
The six-school model is intended as discussion/proposal framework, not a final organizational determination.
