1. Where We Are Now
  - a. Midterm Report Submitted: March 26
  - b. Self-Evaluation Due: August 28
  - c. Site Visit: February 29
2. Midterm Report
  - a. Reports on our progress since our last comprehensive report.
  - b. Went to Cabinet, PBC, AS and the Board before submitting to ACCJC in March.
  - c. The big take-aways from the Midterm Report that we need to address in our next Comprehensive Report are:
    - i. Address the loss of federal funding
    - ii. Our number of transfers goal needs to be reassessed
    - iii. Show continued SLO work and improvements
3. Revision of Accreditation Team Process and Make-up
  - a. The ACCJC's accreditation rubric has been drastically simplified. Our goal is to simplify our accreditation structure and process accordingly. The first step is a revision of AP3200, which has already been put forward to the President's office.
  - b. The goal is to finalize the new structure in fall 26 in order to begin accreditation work in spring 27.
4. Communicating with the Campus about Accreditation
  - a. Accreditation website with updates and materials.
  - b. Reporting to various areas: Academic Senate, Classified Senate, Student Government Association, etc.
  - c. Shifting from "check-box" mentality to accreditation as part of our work at the college
5. Roseland Accreditation Inquiry
  - a. Roseland would need to be accredited if we offer more than 50% of a credit program there.
  - b. Additional resources would need to be allocated to Roseland to meet accreditation requirements.
  - c. Accrediting Roseland might help with the non-credit to credit transition.
