The District shall have library and learning support services that are an integral part of the institution's educational program, comply with the requirements of the Reader Privacy Act, and meet the standards of the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC). The District supports the American Library Association's Bill of Rights and the Association of College and Research Libraries' Standards for Libraries in Higher Education.

Consistent with its mission, the District employs qualified personnel and provides access to library and information resources to support student success, including access to quality, relevant, timely, and accessible information resources in a variety of formats, and instruction in their use.

Faculty librarians, working in collaboration with other Santa Rosa Junior College District faculty, shall have primary responsibility for the identification, selection, coordination and provision of the library's academic resources and collections that meet the information needs of the campus community.
