The District shall provide Student Success and Support Program services to students to further equality of educational opportunity and academic success. The Board establishes policies that ensure the District's commitment to inclusion, diversity, equity, anti-racism and accessibility. The purpose of Student Success and Support Program services is to bring the student and the District into agreement regarding the student's educational goal through the District's established programs, policies, and requirements.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures to assure implementation of Student Success and Support Program services that comply with the Title 5 regulations.
