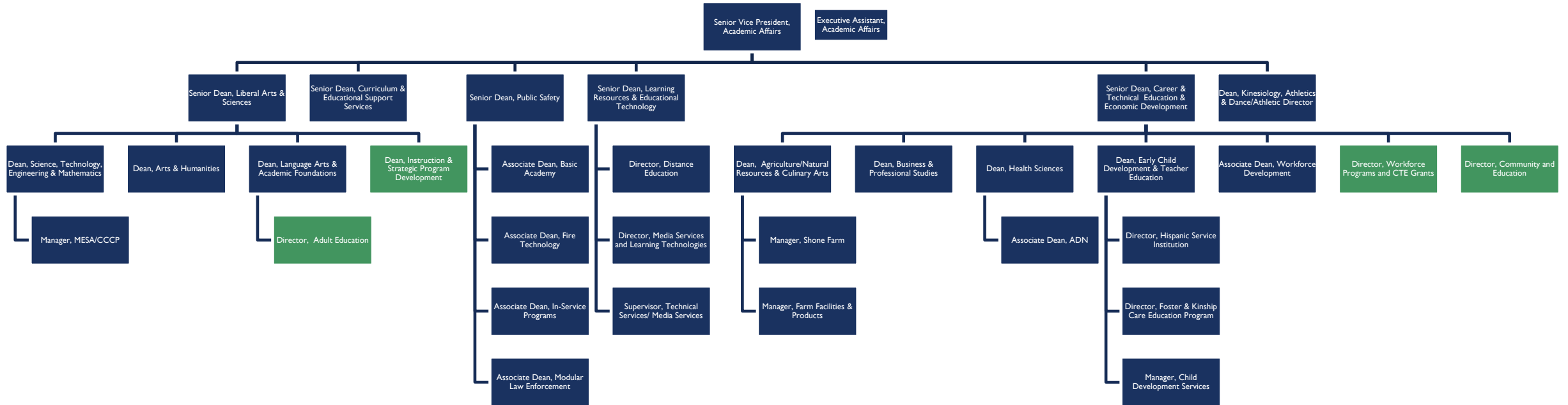

 - Addition of position: Administrative Assistant II, Workforce Programs and CTE Grants (categorically funded, no cost to district)

INSTRUCTION & STRATEGIC PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

DEAN: CATHY PRINCE

- Reporting Changes
 - Now reporting to Senior Dean, Liberal Arts & Sciences for Behavioral and Social Sciences (Reports to SVPAA for grants only)
 - Moving Community Education to Senior Dean, CTE & Economic Development
 - Taking Off-Campus Contracts (High School) from Senior Dean, Curriculum & Educational Support Services
- Museum
 - Reconfiguration of Museum Exhibits Specialist position
 - Name Change: “SRJC Multicultural Museum” to “Jesse Peter Multicultural Museum”

ARTS & HUMANITIES
DEAN: MARK ANDERMAN (INTERIM)

- Name Change: “Theatre Arts” to “Theatre Arts and Fashion”
