Academic Senate Electorate Research

- Napa Valley College
 - Article IV: Membership and Voting Rights All certificated faculty, whether in 0 instruction, counseling, or library services, full- or part-time, permanent or temporary, are members of the Academic Senate and are entitled to the rights granted by this document. All are encouraged to participate in the Senate. SECTION 1: FULL MEMBERSHIP Full Membership status is granted to all Contract (Tenure-Track) and Regular (Tenured) certificated faculty, with a full or partial workload, who are not designated as supervisory or management, and for which the minimum qualifications for hire are specified by the Board of Governors. SECTION 2: ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP Associate Membership status is granted to all Part-Time Hourly and Full-Time Temporary certificated faculty. SECTION 3: VOTING RIGHTS In all votes within the Senate, Full Members shall have one vote, and Associate Members shall have one-half vote. When an Associate Member is a confirmed representative of the Academic Senate to a Senate, Shared Governance, or District committee, s/he shall have a full vote in that committee.
- <u>Woodland Community College</u>
 - SECTION 1 Senate Membership. Membership in the academic senate shall consist of those individuals employed by the Yuba Community College District, who meet the following definition of "faculty." "Faculty" is defined as those employees of the Yuba Community College District who hold the rank of "professor," "instructor," or "adjunct faculty member." An adjunct faculty member is eligible for membership only if currently employed by the district or if that person has a "return right" in the following semester ("return right" as defined in the YCAFT Contract).

<u>Sacramento City College</u>

- Section 2 For all other purposes, the Electorate, hereinafter called the "entire faculty," shall include the regular contract faculty and those faculty persons who teach part-time in the College or other part-time faculty persons who do not perform any service for the College which requires an administrative or supervisory credential.
- <u>Consumnes River College</u>
 - ARTICLE II: ELECTORATE Section 1 The electorate for the tenured and tenuretrack academic senators shall be limited to tenured and tenure-track faculty from the area they represent. Section 2 The electorate for the adjunct academic senators shall be limited to adjunct faculty. Section 3 The electorate for senate officers shall consist of tenured, tenure-track and adjunct
- <u>American River College</u>
 - ARTICLE III: ORGANIZATION The Senate shall consist of members elected from organizational units of the college, as defined in the Senate Bylaws. Bylaws shall make provision for representation both regular and adjunct faculty and shall stipulate terms of office and procedures involving vacancies.
 - The Senate shall also consist of one adjunct faculty member from each Area of American River College
