

- The Educational Planning & Coordinating Council has been reconvened
- EPCC is a standing committee of the Senate and is chaired by the Academic Senate President and Academic Affairs Vice President. Faculty members were recruited through a call that went out two weeks ago. The Council had its first meeting last Thursday.
- EPCC was reconvened to assist with the review of policies in preparation for accreditation.
- The College has roughly 50 policies that must be reviewed.
- The policies in question have been assigned to supervising administrators to convert to the CCLC template format and review for other necessary updates and changes.
- Policies will then come to EPCC for review before moving on in the approval process, which for this round will be expedited.
- Some policies may be flagged to return for further work post approval. Senators are encouraged to flag those policies and procedures that they would like to see return to the Senate for further work after this current, expedited round of approval.
- The AS can expect to see many of these policies, when appropriate, on the Consent Agenda
- At our first meeting we discussed process, a work plan, and the development of criteria and/or a rubric for policy review. We convene again next week.
