This report is divided into three sections to clarify the work we have completed as it relates to the Professional Development Committee, SRJC Faculty Professional Development, and our New Faculty Professional Learning Program.

1. Professional Development Committee
 - a. Meet with PDC 2x per month to support PDA review and planning

2. Faculty Professional Development Work
 - a. Consult with various institutional partners about faculty professional development needs at SRJC
 - b. Monthly meetings with VPAA
 - c. Professional Development Reporting
 - i. Created and shared a Professional Development Reporting Tool for faculty to use since the current reporting system is not fully functional. This task was inspired by the number questions we fielded at the end of Spring semester when faculty tried reporting their FLEX and experienced a range of issues (e.g. reusing an FF number).
 - d. Communication Efforts and Hopes
 - i. Distribute a monthly e-mail to all faculty with a list of SRJC-based PD opportunities along with online and off campus PD opportunities.
 - ii. Working on additional communication processes to promote PD and provide information in a transparent and accessible manner. Need administrative assistance support for items 1-3 below.
 1. Create a newsletter template and distribution schedule to replace the monthly e-mails.
 2. Develop a PD Calendar to promote SRJC-based faculty professional development.
