Program Mapping: Why? and Why First?

- **Clarification of Academic Pathways:** Provides students with clear, structured course sequences that guide them
- **Informed Decision-Making:** Students make more informed decisions about their academic journey. Students can see how different courses connect to their career or transfer goals
- **Improved Completion Rates:** Students are more likely to complete their degree or certificate on time.
- **Equity and Access:** Reduces disparities in educational outcomes. Ensures all students have access to the same information and opportunities to succeed

- Major requirements only- does not include all pre-reqs or General Ed

Program Mapping

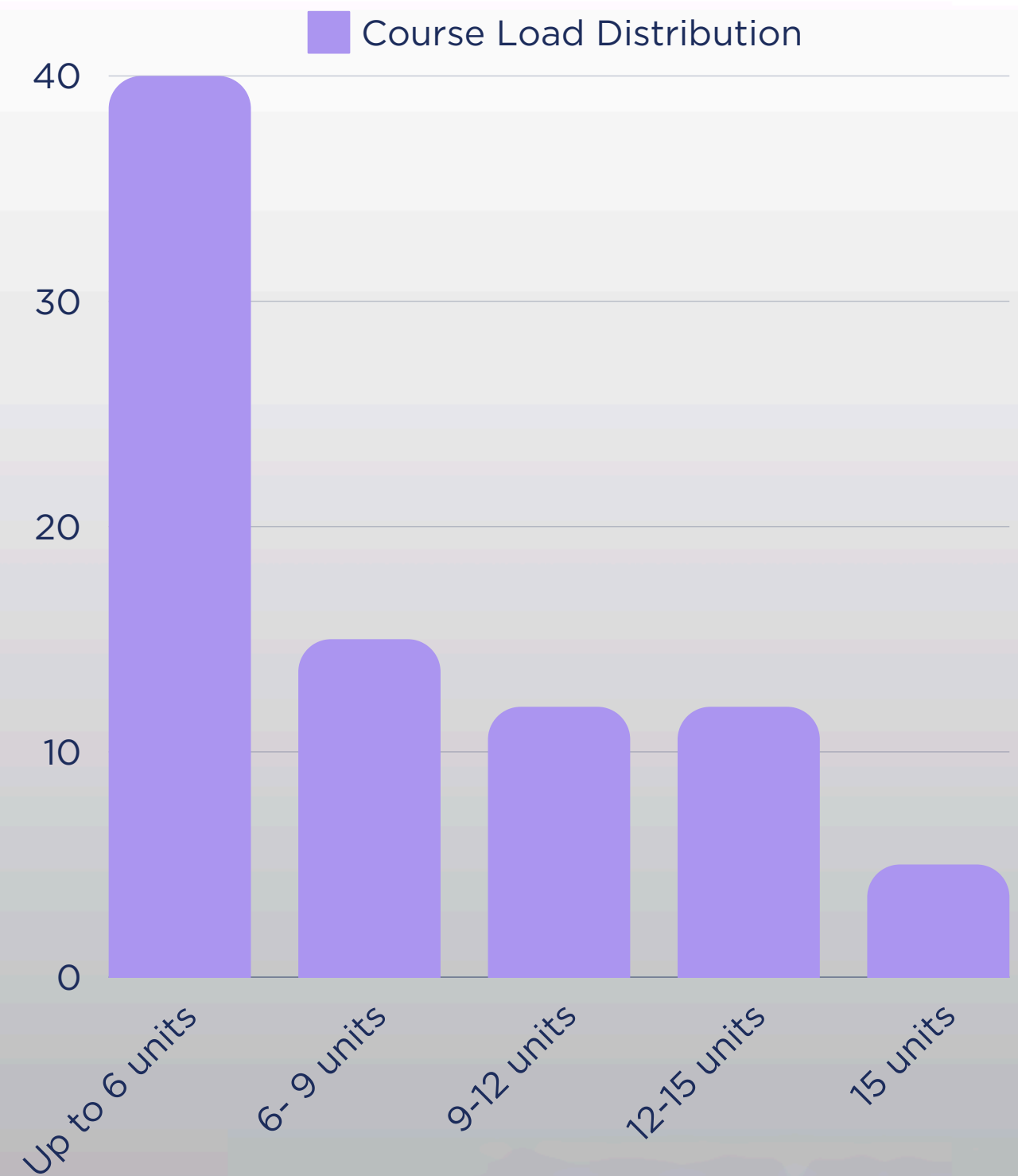
What is needed:

Maps at average of 6, 9, & 12 units

Student Course Load Distribution

- 40% of students take 1-6 units.
- 15% of students take 6-9 units.
- 12% of students take 9-12 units.
- 12% of students take 12-15 units.
- 5% of students take 15 units.
