**RE:** SLO Faculty Workgroup Recommendations

The SLO Faculty Workgroup submits the following recommendations to the Academic Senate.

## Recommendation 1

The SLO Faculty Workgroup recommends that regular assessment be defined as courses having all SLOs assessed at least every two years.

## Recommendation 2

The SLO Faculty Workgroup recommends that courses must have updated SLO assessments as a prerequisite for course review by the Curriculum Review Committee.

## Recommendation 3

The SLO Faculty Workgroup recommends that all SLO assessments be disaggregated by the demographic groups that are identified in SRJC's Student Equity Plan 2.0 and annual Integrated Postsecondary Education System (IPEDS) report. This would not preclude individual faculty or instructional Departments from also choosing to analyze SLO assessment data that are disaggregated by additional student populations or demographic groups.
