Listed in Order of Strategies and Goals

Strategy 1, Goal One Objective: change the word "promote" to something more concrete and action-based (*April 5th*).

- **Note** synonyms for "promote" from Oxford Languages: encourage; further; advance; assist; aid; help; contribute to; foster; nurture; develop; boost; stimulate; forward; advocate; recommend.
- **Note** is this a necessary change?

Strategy 1, Goals One and Two should be swapped, as SRJC is a student-based institution (April 5^{th}).

• **Note** – this is a simple change that could be made without dramatically changing the meaning of the current plan.

Strategy 1, Goal One. Senator language suggestion made: "Promoting robust professional development and maintaining professional development resources in support of discipline expertise as necessary for academic quality and culturally responsive andragogy as related to the first strategy" (*April 19th*).

- Note if changes are made...
 - This is a major, substantive change that alters the goal as already determined by multiple constituencies and faculty in a previously defined and accepted process.
 - o Culturally responsive pedagogy is not depended on discipline expertise.

Strategy 2, Goal One. A concern about the use of the term "ecosystem" in relation to educational communities and campus cultures (*April 19*th); suggested to change the term to "community" (*May 3*rd).

• **Note** – is this a necessary change?

Strategy 2, Goal Two. Should include implementation of students accessing basic needs; suggestion to include the word "academic" in front of "basic needs" ($May 3^{rd}$).

• **Note** – suggestion was not amendable to goals as they are written without degrading the quality of the goal as already exists.

Strategy 3: Confusion on the term "Social Economic Needs" and thought it should state "Socioeconomic Needs" (May 3rd).

 Note – should we recommend that "social, economic" be amended to read, in full, "ensure that SRJC is supporting the diverse educational, cultural, and socio-economic needs of our community"?
