

## **Student Learning Outcome Coordinators Recommendation to the Academic Senate** (Smita Avasthi & Emily Schmidt)

In order to ensure that *all* learning outcomes are appropriately assessed, reported, and analyzed, the Student Learning Outcome Coordinators recommend the creation of an Outcomes and Assessment Committee:

The Outcomes and Assessment Committee is charged with coordinating the assessments of Institutional, Service Area, Program, General Education, and Course SLOs as follows:

- Recommend ongoing and systematic procedures for the assessment, reporting, and analysis of Institutional, Service Area, Program, General Education, and Course SLOs.
- Review and maintain processes to ensure current practices are relevant, meaningful, and sustainable.
- Promote ongoing, pervasive, and robust dialogue about course design, outcomes, and student learning.
- Consult with IERP and DE on the collection, analysis, and reporting of outcomes and assessment data.
- Consult with Deans and Chairs to ensure that Institutional, Service Area, Program, General Education, and Course SLOs are appropriately mapped.

Committee Membership: (We recommend no more than 12 members.)

- 5 administrators
  - VP Academic Affairs or designee
  - Dean of Academic Affairs or designee
  - VP Student Services or designee
  - Director of IERP or designee
  - Director of Distance Education or designee
- 7 Faculty
  - Academic Senate President or designee
  - 2 contract faculty
  - 2 associate faculty (with compensation, as on Faculty Equivalency)
  - 2 SLO coordinators
